

As already notified vide Advertisement Notice No:- 02-AH of 2024; Dated:- 12-03-2024, the selection shall be made purely on the basis of merit obtained by the candidates in the written test.

In case of tie in the merit obtained in the written test, the following procedures shall be followed to break the tie:

- a) In case of tie between Post-Graduates and Graduates, the Post-Graduate candidate will be given preference.
- b) In case of tie between two or more graduates, the candidate having secured higher percentage of marks in Graduation will be preferred.



- c) In case of tie between Graduates and Diploma holders, the Graduate candidate will be given preference.
- d) In case of tie between Diploma holders, the candidate having higher percentage of marks in the Diploma will be preferred.
- e) In case the tie is not resolved by the above methodology, the candidate older in age shall be given preference.

In this context, the applicants are advised to strictly follow the instructions given below for participation in the examination:

1. Download "Admit Card" from official website of this institution i.e. [www.gmcs.ac.in](http://www.gmcs.ac.in) w.e.f **15.04.2025 (04.30 PM onwards)**.
2. On the actual date of examination i.e **20.04.2025**, the candidates shall report to the respective venues one (01) hour before commencement of examination for verification of their identity. They will carry along their Admit Cards and any one the following documents as proof of their identity;
  - a) Photo ID Card issued by the Competent Authority, or
  - b) Driving License, or
  - c) PAN Card/Aadhar Card
3. Avoid carrying any unauthorized material (e.g. written notes, paper etc.) and not to carry any electronic and communication gadgets like mobile phone, tablet, smart watch etc. Please note that there shall not be any arrangement for keeping these things in the examination hall and the candidates have to leave them outside the examination hall on their own risk and responsibility.
4. The candidates shall restrain themselves from wearing face masks and carrying any metallic item including watches, ear-rings, rings etc., besides also avoid long shoes in the examination centre.
5. Avoid carrying any eatables in the examination hall; however, transparent water bottles shall be allowed.
6. Place the admit card and valid ID card on the desk throughout the examination.
7. Comply with the instructions of invigilators at all times. For example, if you are asked to sit in a designated place then you must do so and you must not move. Any kind of copying including side talk is punishable. Do not disobey any instruction/s issued to you by the invigilator.
8. Use only blue or black point pen to fill the details and responses on the OMR sheets.

9. Read the instructions thoroughly on the question booklet and OMR sheet which shall be provided before the commencement of the test.
10. Make sure that you have completely and correctly written your Roll No. and other required details on the OMR sheets and cover page of the question booklet.
11. The candidates shall restrain themselves from sharing any other materials or communicate with or seek help from other candidates during the test.
12. Avoid stray mark or writing anything on any part of the OMR sheet except in the places wherever needed.
13. Use the blank page at the end of the question booklet for rough work, if need arises.
14. Use of whitener, eraser, nails, rubber, blade, etc. on the answer sheet is completely prohibited.
15. Stop writing and tear off the strip at the perforation line on the top of the OMR sheet to separate carbon copy from the original OMR sheet without damaging edges of the OMR sheet and handover the original copy of OMR sheet to the invigilator after stipulated time is over. You must not leave your seat until all OMR sheets are collected and counted by the invigilator.
