Subject: Suspension case of Mr. Amit Kumar, Multitasking Staff, Department of Microbiology, Govt. Medical College, Srinagar – Settlement of Suspension Period.

Whereas, Mr. Amit Kumar, was appointment as Multitasking Staff vide Govt. Order No. 669 – AH of 2018 Dated: 01-12-2018 and consequently posted at Head Department of Microbiology, GMC, Srinagar vide Order No. 755 – AH of 2018 Dated: 20-12-2018; and

Whereas, Head Department of Microbiology, Govt. Medical College, Srinagar vide letter No. HOD/Micro/2023/2182-83 Dated: 29-11-2023 reported that the official remained unauthorized absent since 15-11-2023; and

Whereas, this office upon receipt of various reports from Head Department of Microbiology, Govt. Medical College, Srinagar placed the official under suspension vide Order No. 937 – AH of 2024 Dated: 02-01-2024 besides attaching the official with Medical Superintendent, Govt. Bone and Joint Hospital, Srinagar; and

Whereas, in response to the above suspension order, the official submitted his explanation on 02-01-2024 citing health reasons therein; and

Whereas, this office requested Member Secretary, Standing Medical Board, Govt. SMHS Hospital, Srinagar vide letter No. AH-09/Est-III/2023/8933 Dated: 13-03-2023 to re-examine the medical documents/prescriptions produced by the official; and

Whereas, this office released 50% subsistence allowance in favour of the official from the date of suspension vide letter No. AH-Est-I/2024/9107 Dated: 22-03-2024; and

Whereas, another reminder was issued to Member Secretary, Standing Medical Board Govt. SMHS Hospital, Srinagar vide letter No. AH-09/EST-I/2024/369 Dated: 16-04-2024; and

Whereas, Member Secretary, Standing Medical Board Govt. SMHS Hospital, Srinagar vide letter No. MB/SMHS/636 Dated: 24-04-2024 reported that the case was examined and the report is reproduced as under:-

“Neurological Opinion:- After assessing clinically Mr. Amit Kumar and revising the records attached with the letter, we have found that he had Acute Low Back Acne in November and December 2023, with Radicular pain in left leg. This pain has needed treatment in SKIMS, and Acute treatment at Jammu Super Specialty Hospital and a private Hospital. Presently patient persists with MILD LBA and radicular pain with no Neuro deficit on examination.”

Orthopedic Opinion:- As per records patient has LBP L4-5 discs.”
