C I R C U L A R

A good number of employees belonging to Jammu and Kashmir Industries Corporations are presently serving in Government Medical College and It's Associated Hospitals Srinagar on deputation basis. In light of the instructions issued by the General Administration Department Civil Secretariat, Srinagar/ Jammu vide circular No:- GAD/Accts/Dep/Corp/2016 Dated:- 21-07-2016, such employees are required to be repatriated to their respective parent organization three months before their superannuation, in order enable General Administration Department to take further necessary course of action as per rules/ norms, so that the parent organization shall take necessary action under the relevant rules in the matter.

Accordingly, it is impressed upon all the Medical Superintendents/ Drawing and Disbursing officer of this institution that they shall relieve/repatriate such employees to their respective parent Corporations at least three months prior to their date of retirement.

Subject: Repatriation of the employees of Corporations on deputation to various Government Departments/Commissions, Boards and other Corporations.

CIRCULAR

It has been observed that some employees of the State-owned Corporations temporarily deployed in the Government Departments have filed Legal cases seeking post-retirement benefits as are available in the case of Government employees, on the basis of LPC issued in their favour. Some of the Managing Directors of the Corporations have expressed their concern over the instant issue and have requested for repatriation of such employees at least one month ahead of their retirement date.

The employees of the Corporations are not entitled for retirement benefits at par with Government employees. They are seeking retirement benefits from the borrowing Government Departments/Commissions/Boards by way of litigations and as such need to be discouraged.

All the Departments are, therefore, requested to relieve the employees of Corporations, deployed in the Government Departments/Commissions or Boards, at least three months ahead of their retirement enabling their repatriation by General Administration Department.
