C I R C U L A R

It is hereby notified for the information of all students that this College continues to enforce a Zero Tolerance Policy towards ragging in any form, in strict compliance with the directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the University Grants Commission (UGC), and the National Medical Commission (NMC).

Ragging, whether occurring within or outside the College premises, is recognized as a criminal offence under prevailing laws and is punishable with imprisonment, fine, or both. Any student found guilty of engaging in ragging, directly or indirectly, shall face severe disciplinary action, including suspension, expulsion, and initiation of legal proceedings as per applicable statutes and regulations.

All students are reminded of their responsibility to nurture a campus environment that is safe, inclusive, and respectful. Senior students are expected to act as mentors and guides to their juniors, fostering a culture of empathy, cooperation, and mutual respect. Such values are integral to preserving the dignity of this institution and ensuring a ragging-free campus where learning and integrity thrive.

Students subjected to ragging or those who witness such incidents are urged to report immediately through any of the following channels:

- **In Person:** Approach any Head of Department/ Faculty Member or Anti-Ragging Committee or Anti-Ragging Squad.
- **Digitally:** Report via the following official channels:

 - Fill online Grievance Form by scanning the QR Code
- **Directly to the Principal/Dean.**
